Life in China is now ruled by a green symbol on a smartphone screen. Green is the “health code” that says a user is [symptom-free](#) and it’s required to board a subway, check into a hotel or just enter Wuhan, according to AP reporting.

The U.S. and European nations are evaluating the use of [phone-based surveillance technology](#) to help combat the spread of COVID-19. The U.S. federal government, in coordination with the CDC, is creating a portal to track phone geolocation data to help predict where outbreaks could occur next. Researchers at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology developed an app that tracks COVID-19 patients and those they interact with. Some European nations are tracking individuals who have been exposed to the virus and must be quarantined.

The Kansas Department of Health and Environment is using a GPS program to [track residents’ locations](#) through their cell phones in a bid to slow coronavirus cases, Dr. Lee Norman, the head of department, revealed in a press conference Wednesday, 04/01/2020. Kansas is the first state to publicly acknowledge its use of such a program.

Rob Jackson, chair of the Global Carbon Project, reported [carbon emissions could fall](#) by as much as 5% year-on-year as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. Such a decrease would be the biggest drop in carbon emissions since World War Two. Scientists warn carbon emissions will go back up once confinement practices end since there have been no structural changes to facilitate long-term emissions reduction.

American cities and states are working to provide shelter and health services to the [homeless population](#), which is considered to be vulnerable to COVID-19. The \$2 trillion relief bill passed and signed in March provides \$12 billion to state and local governments to help get homeless people off the streets. There is not currently any national data tracking confirmed COVID-19 cases amongst the homeless, though Los Angeles County reported two such cases. Researchers from three universities released a study last week estimating 4.3% of the nation’s homeless population could be killed by the virus and more than 21,000 will need to be hospitalized.

Captain Brett Crozier, commander of the aircraft carrier USS Theodore Roosevelt, was [relieved of his command](#) on Thursday, 04/02/2020, after drafting a strongly worded letter asking for assistance to control the outbreak of COVID-19 aboard the ship. Acting Navy Secretary Thomas Modly said Crozier was relieved of his command for failing to use the chain of command to report the issue and for sending his letter over “non-secure unclassified email.” Crozier will reportedly keep his rank and remain in the Navy.

Morgan Stanley forecasted the [U.S. economy](#) will shrink 5.5% in 2020—the steepest drop since 1946—and will experience 38% contraction in the second quarter. Morgan Stanley also reports unemployment will peak at 15.7% in the second quarter. U.S. Congressional Budget Office projections show greater than 7% decline in gross domestic product in the second quarter.

Digital Exploitation

[Marriott International](#) disclosed on Tuesday 03/31/2020 a new data breach that impacted 5.2 million guests, according to CNET reporting. The hotel group said information exposed may include names, addresses, emails, phone numbers and birthdays as well as loyalty account details and information like room preferences.

ThreatPost reporting provided details about a spoofing campaign that promises users important information about new coronavirus cases in their local area. The [phishing emails](#) don't include specific names or greetings in the body of the messages, suggesting they are being sent out to a broad target audience.

A separate ThreatPost report indicates [older phishing kits](#) that were previously deployed and then retired are resurfacing and targeting people working from home. Attackers are using recycled phishing kits from as far back as July 2019 in coronavirus-based phishing attacks.

Security researchers are now seeing [malware](#) that either wipes everything off the computers of victims, or corrupts the master boot record of Windows machines so the computer hard drive is unusable. There's no financial gain from doing this. According to IT World Canada, victims will know they've been hit if a message pops up saying coronavirus has been installed.

[Microsoft](#) has started to send targeted notifications to dozens of hospitals about vulnerable public-facing VPN devices and gateways located on their network. As part of their tracking of various groups behind human-operated ransomware attacks, Microsoft has seen one of the operations known as REvil (Sodinokibi) targeting vulnerabilities in VPN devices and gateway appliances to breach a network, according to BleepingComputer.

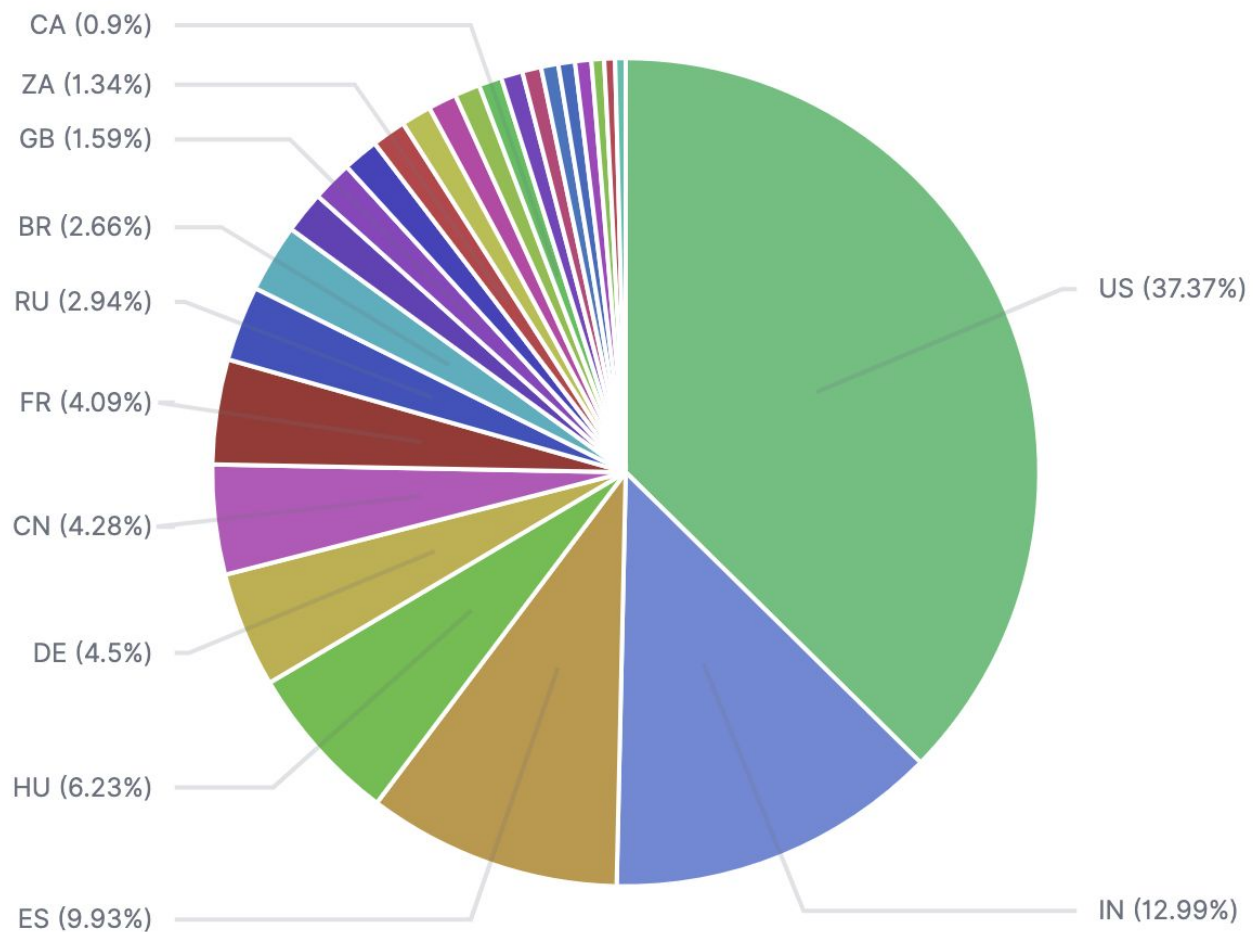

COVID-19 Email Spam Statistics

RiskIQ analyzed its spam box feed for the time period of 04/02/2020-04/03/2020. During this period, RiskIQ analyzed 222,897 spam emails containing either “*corona*” or “*covid*” in the subject line. There were 16,097 unique subject lines observed during the reporting period. The spam emails originated from 9,190 unique sending email domains and 17,839 unique SMTP IP Addresses. Analysts identified 313 emails which sent an executable file for Windows machines.

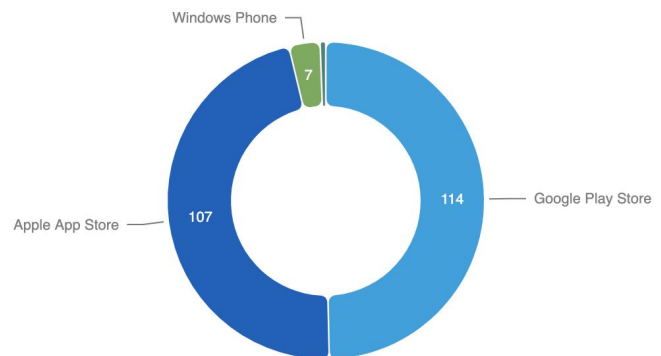

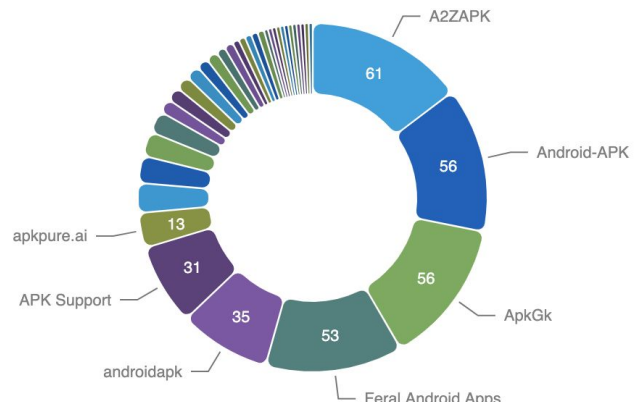

Governmental Guidance

State & Local Governments

California

As of 04/03/2020, California has 11,126 confirmed COVID-19 cases and 244 deaths. Governor Newsom [announced](#) yesterday, 04/02/2020, a financial relief package for small businesses amid the COVID-19 pandemic. The package allows small businesses with less than \$5 million in taxable sales to defer payment up to \$50,000 for one year. Newsom also announced a new job search tool for Californians who are out of work due to the pandemic.

Illinois

As of 04/03/2020, Illinois has 7,697 confirmed cases of COVID-19 and 167 deaths. Governor J.B. Pritzker [announced](#) Thursday, 04/02/2020, Illinois will receive 15 machines to process rapid results for COVID-19 tests. Pritzker stated the first shipment was expected Thursday night. These rapid tests, developed by North Chicago-based Abbott Labs, deliver positive results within five minutes and negative results within 13 minutes.

Massachusetts

As of 04/03/2020, Massachusetts has 8,966 confirmed cases of COVID-19 and 154 deaths. Governor Charlie Baker [announced](#) yesterday, 04/02/2020, Massachusetts will soon hit a peak in COVID-19 cases. Baker stated models show the peak is expected to hit between April 10 and April 20, with expected confirmed cases totaling between 47,000 and 172,000. Massachusetts officials are planning to prepare for the surge based on these models.

New York

As of 04/03/2020, New York has 9,243 confirmed COVID-19 cases and 2,468 deaths. Governor Cuomo [stated](#) Thursday, 04/02/2020, in a Press Conference that New York has a total of 2,200 ventilators. This stockpile is expected to last about six days at the current rate of the pandemic. Cuomo stated there are other measures in place if it is necessary, including transporting ventilators from hospitals.

Washington, DC

As of 04/03/2020, the Washington, D.C. region has a total of 4,580 confirmed COVID-19 cases with 1,706 in Virginia, 2,331 in Maryland, and 653 in the District. Washington D.C. is [expected](#) to hit its peak of COVID-19 cases around April 15. Mayor Muriel Bowser is expected to announce medical plans today to prepare for the surge. Maryland is expected to hit its surge around April 29, and Virginia is not expected to surge until May 20.
