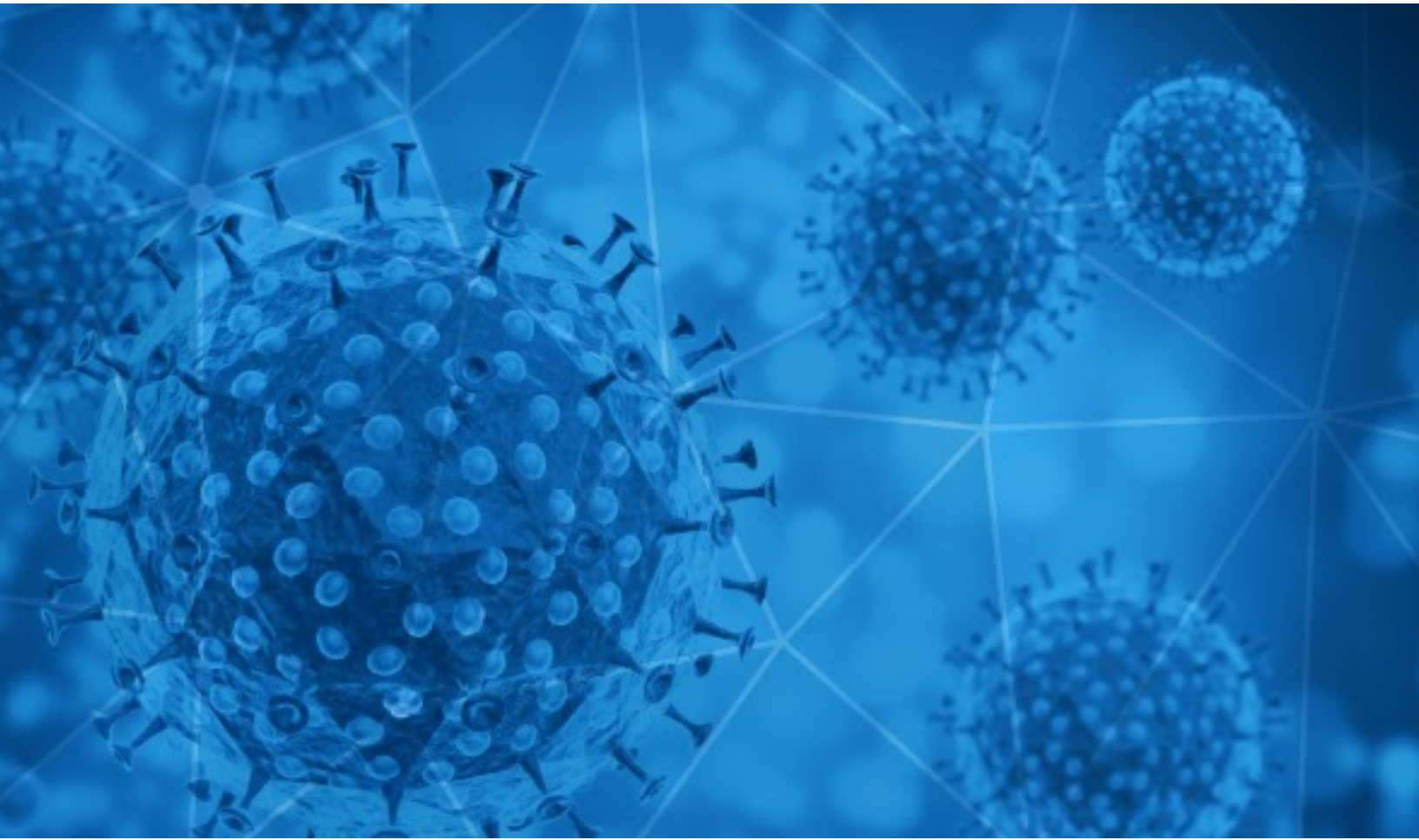

Notable Events: Previous 24 Hours

The American Thoracic Society (ATS), which specializes in the treatment of respiratory diseases, [issued guidelines](#) for medical practitioners to use hydroxychloroquine or chloroquine on COVID-19 patients. ATS guidelines say the drugs can be used if shared decision-making is possible, the patient is ill enough to warrant its use, data can be collected to compare outcomes, and the drug is not in short supply. The ATS said current data about the drugs' efficacy is contradictory, but experimental use of the drug is warranted during the crisis.

[Stock futures](#) are pointing to more gains as markets see optimism COVID-19 cases may be slowing. In the U.S., the S&P 500 gained 7%, the Dow Jones Industrial Average grew by 7.7%, and the Nasdaq grew by 7.3% Likewise, both European and Asian markets also experienced gains in their respective markets.

Major League Baseball (MLB) is mulling over [beginning the season](#) in May, with all thirty teams playing in Phoenix, AZ in empty stadiums. MLB officials stated any plans to begin the regular season would be contingent on the public health situation improving to where it is safe to do so.

The Trump administration ordered [167 million face](#) masks from the 3M Company over the next three months. The administration invoked the Defense Production Act against the company last week. 3M reported it is working with the Trump administration to resume imports from its Chinese factory.

Five researchers from Harvard University discovered that individuals with long-term exposure to air pollution had [increased mortality](#) from COVID-19. The study concluded, "A small increase in long-term exposure to [particulate matter] leads to a large increase in COVID-19 death rate, with the magnitude of increase 20 times that observed for [particulate matter] and all cause mortality." The authors reported an increase in air pollution of one gram per cubic meter led to as much as a 15% increase in mortality.

Wisconsin voters waited in long lines to vote in the state's [primary election](#) on Tuesday, 04/07/2020. Thousands of voters who registered for absentee ballots will not receive them in time and must choose between voting in person or skipping voting.

New York Governor Andrew Cuomo reported President Trump agreed to allow COVID-19 patients to be treated aboard the [USNS Comfort](#), providing an additional 1,000 beds.

U.K. Prime Minister Boris Johnson is reported to be in [stable condition](#) and is not presently on a ventilator. Johnson is receiving oxygen treatment without ventilation and does not have pneumonia at this time.

Digital Exploitation

Cyber actors are spoofing Zoom and other remote working tools to deploy malware, according to LookingGlass Global Intelligence Update. These fake Zoom invitations are socially engineered to target those unfamiliar with Zoom to install cryptocurrency miners, adware, and/or remote access trojans. Related, Michigan's chief federal, state, and local law enforcement officials joined together to warn anyone who hacks into a teleconference that they [can be charged](#) with state or federal crimes. According to Michigan's Department of Justice, the charges may include disrupting a public meeting, computer intrusion, using a computer to commit a crime, hate crimes, fraud, or transmitting threatening communications.

[NASA](#) has experienced an exponential increase in malware attacks and a doubling of agency devices trying to access malicious sites in the past few days, the space agency's Office of the Chief Information Officer said on Monday 4/06/2020. Tricking people into clicking on malicious links or opening malicious email attachments remains one of the easiest ways to gain entry into enterprise networks and individual computers users alike.

Kentucky FBI Special Agent in Charge Robert Brown warned about [robo-calls](#) selling fake medical supplies like masks or COVID-19 tests. He also warned there are fake testing tents that offer coronavirus tests for \$240 and the criminals take people's Medicaid and Social Security information.

London police have seen as many as [50 scam reports](#) a day with many related to an email asking for donations to buy "medical preparations and supplies" for the National Health Service to cope with COVID-19. Other scams purporting to be official messages from the government include texts telling people they have been fined £250 for leaving their home more than once during the lockdown, according to the Guardian.

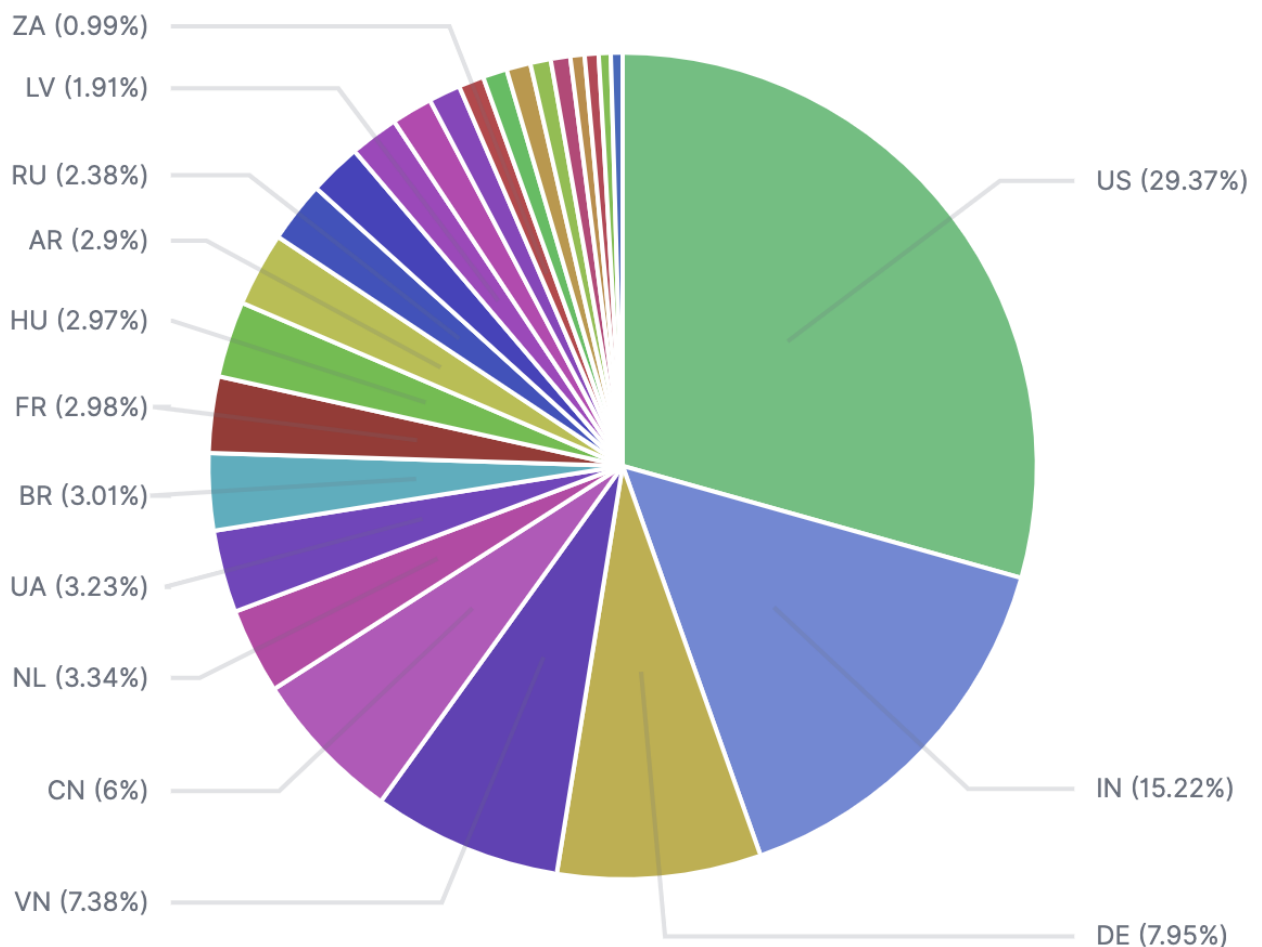
Interpol has issued an alert to global police about the heightened risk of ransomware attacks on hospitals and other front-line organizations as they battle the COVID-19 pandemic. The law enforcement organization said it issued a [Purple Notice](#) to all 194 member countries, highlighting the scale of the threat, according to Info Security reporting.

COVID-19 Email Spam Statistics

RiskIQ analyzed its spam box feed for the time period of 04/06/2020-04/07/2020. During this period, RiskIQ analyzed 249,907 spam emails containing either “*corona*” or “*covid*” in the subject line. There were 17,461 unique subject lines observed during the reporting period. The spam emails originated from 9,156 unique sending email domains and 15,884 unique SMTP IP Addresses. Analysts identified 2,418 emails which sent an executable file for Windows machines.

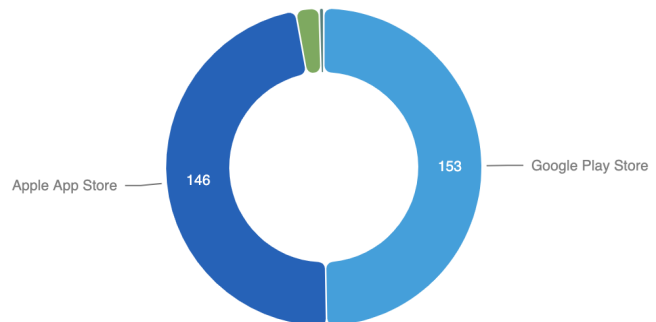

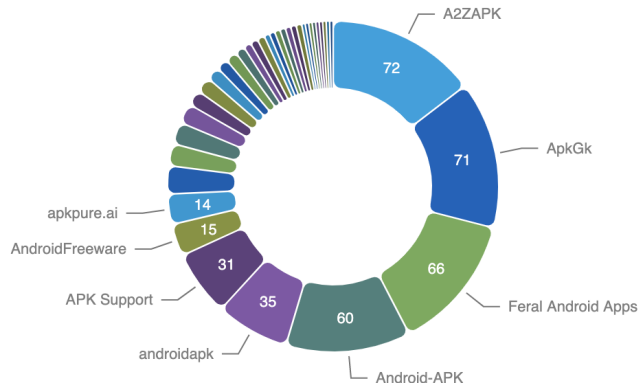

Governmental Guidance

State & Local Governments

California

As of 04/07/2020, California has 16,363 confirmed COVID-19 cases and 388 deaths. Six Bay Area counties (Alameda, Contra Costa, Marin, San Mateo, San Francisco and Santa Clara) now require [grocery stores to ban reusable bags](#), pausing the environment-friendly policy that did away with single-use plastic bags, due to coronavirus health concerns. In their shelter-in-place orders extended to May 3, counties required chains, such as Safeway and Whole Foods, and local stores to ban reusable bags and to offer single-use plastic and paper bags. San Francisco was among the first cities in the country to ban single-use plastic bags in 2007.

Illinois

As of 04/07/2020, Illinois has 12,264 confirmed cases of COVID-19 and 308 deaths. Warm weather is sparking concerns that residents will ignore social distancing guidelines and a state stay-at-home order issued to curb the spread of the new coronavirus. Since March 20, the Chicago Police Department [issued](#) 1,600 group dispersals and 11 citations to people in violation of the stay-at-home order, and arrested three others. Mayor Lori Lightfoot warned Monday that the city would step up [enforcement efforts](#) as the weather warmed.

Massachusetts

As of 04/07/2020, Massachusetts has confirmed 13,837 cases of COVID-19 and 260 deaths. [A testing site in Lowell](#) opened Tuesday in partnership with CVS Health and is the first rapid, drive-through site open to the public. Governor Baker said it will test up to 1,000 patients per day with results available in 15 minutes.

New York

As of 04/07/2020, New York has confirmed 131,830 COVID-19 cases and 7,758 deaths. New York [reported](#) Monday its largest single-day increase in deaths related to COVID-19 at 731.

Washington, DC

As of 04/07/2020, the Washington, DC region has a total of 8,926 confirmed COVID-19 cases with 3,340 in Virginia, 4,371 in Maryland, and 1,215 in the District. The District of Columbia has a total of 23 deaths, Virginia has 63, and Maryland has 103 deaths. The DC region [reported](#) Monday its largest single-day increase in deaths related to COVID-19 at 169. Officials warned that the region could become one of the country's next hot spots, with hospitals preparing for a surge.
