## Notable Events: Previous 24 Hours

The lockdown in Wuhan, China, which has been in effect since 01/23/2020, has been lifted for residents. Those with a “green” code on a smartphone app that tracks health status will be allowed to [leave their homes](#).

Twitter CEO Jack Dorsey will set aside [\\$1 billion](#)—28% of his wealth—in his Square equity to support COVID-19 relief efforts. Dorsey said the money would be used for causes like universal basic income and girls’ health and education when the pandemic is over.

The [Treasury Inspector General for Tax Administration](#) (TIGTA) issued a news release warning Americans to be vigilant for scams relating to government assistance via the CARES Act. TIGTA said previous government assistance efforts have been targeted by scammers and it is likely criminals will use the financial assistance many Americans expect to receive from the government as a means to scam victims.

[Michigan](#) and [New Jersey](#) both saw record highs for COVID-19-related fatalities on Tuesday, 04/07/2020. Michigan reported 118 deaths, while New Jersey reported 232 deaths.

The University of Washington’s Institute for Health Metrics and Evaluation COVID-19 modeling now estimates [60,000](#) Americans will die from the virus, a 26% decrease from previous forecasts. The institute now estimates the projected peak of COVID-19 deaths will occur this Sunday, with 2,212 deaths expected.

President Trump on Tuesday said he would place [federal funding](#) to the World Health Organization (WHO) on hold. Trump was critical of the organization’s handling of the COVID-19 crisis and said it was too China-centric. Senator Lindsey Graham, R-SC, also vowed to provide no funding to the WHO, calling the organization “Chinese apologists.”

According to Washington Post reporting, African-Americans are [disproportionately affected](#) by COVID-19. Counties that are majority-black have three times the rate of infections and six times the rate of fatalities compared to majority-white counties. President Trump acknowledged the disparity in African-American deaths during a Tuesday press briefing, stating the administration was looking into the matter and would have statistics over the next two to three days.

The Department of Health and Human Services announced its [first contract](#) for ventilator production under the Defense Production Act to General Motors. The \$489.4 million contract calls for 30,000 ventilators to be produced for the Strategic National Stockpile.

Nearly [a third of U.S. apartment renters didn't pay](#) any of their April rent during the first week of the month, according to new data to be released Wednesday by the National Multifamily Housing Council and a consortium of real-estate data providers. The numbers are the first hard look at how many Americans are struggling to make rent during the coronavirus pandemic. The data come in the first of weekly reports on unpaid rent from NMHC, a landlord trade group.

## Digital Exploitation

A joint advisory published today 4/08/2020 by the U.K.'s National Cyber Security Centre (NCSC) and U.S. [Department of Homeland Security](#) (DHS) Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA) shows that malicious groups online are targeting individuals and organizations with a range of ransomware and malware. The cyber criminals are also scanning for vulnerabilities in software and remote working tools, the agencies say. Likewise, CISA warned on 4/03/2020 that cybercriminals are exploiting critical vulnerabilities associated with the [Firefox browser](#). To address these flaws, Firefox was updated to plug the holes, and users should automatically receive these updates unless they disabled this capability.

[China's gamers](#) were the largest group of victims amid a spike in internet [scams](#) during the country's COVID-19 outbreak as millions of quarantined people turned to online games to alleviate boredom. The Chinese experience should serve as a warning to other gamers as [gaming](#) services like Twitch and Discord are booming with millions of people shifting to life online, according to Bloomberg News.

Researchers found at least 10,450 accounts on Instagram that have popped up in the past few months [selling masks](#), some of which appear to be scams and most of which aren't vetted for safety or price concerns, according to the Washington Post.

The NFL commissioner Roger Goodell on 4/06/2020 informed teams that they are to conduct their draft operations [remotely](#). With a draft that is solely done online, it could be a target for professional hackers, and that has some teams worried, including Ravens coach John Harbaugh who noted his concern given recent reporting related to "Zoombombing," according to the [Baltimore Sun](#) and [Star Telegram](#).

One of [Zoom's shareholders](#) filed a class action lawsuit against the company. The shareholder said he lost money after the company "overstated" its security measures, which led its share price to tank. Zoom was hit with another suit last month after Zoom's iOS app was found to have shared data with Facebook, even when users did not have a Facebook account. Zoom has worked to improve its image in the past week, including a promise to improve its encryption efforts and by changing its default settings to prevent trolls and intruders from accessing Zoom calls without permission.

As the COVID-19 pandemic forces the largest-ever remote work force it could supercharge the cybersecurity industry's shift to [cloud services](#), according to the Wall Street Journal. The pivot to working from home highlights the benefits of cloud-based services that can quickly scale up defenses around decentralized employees.

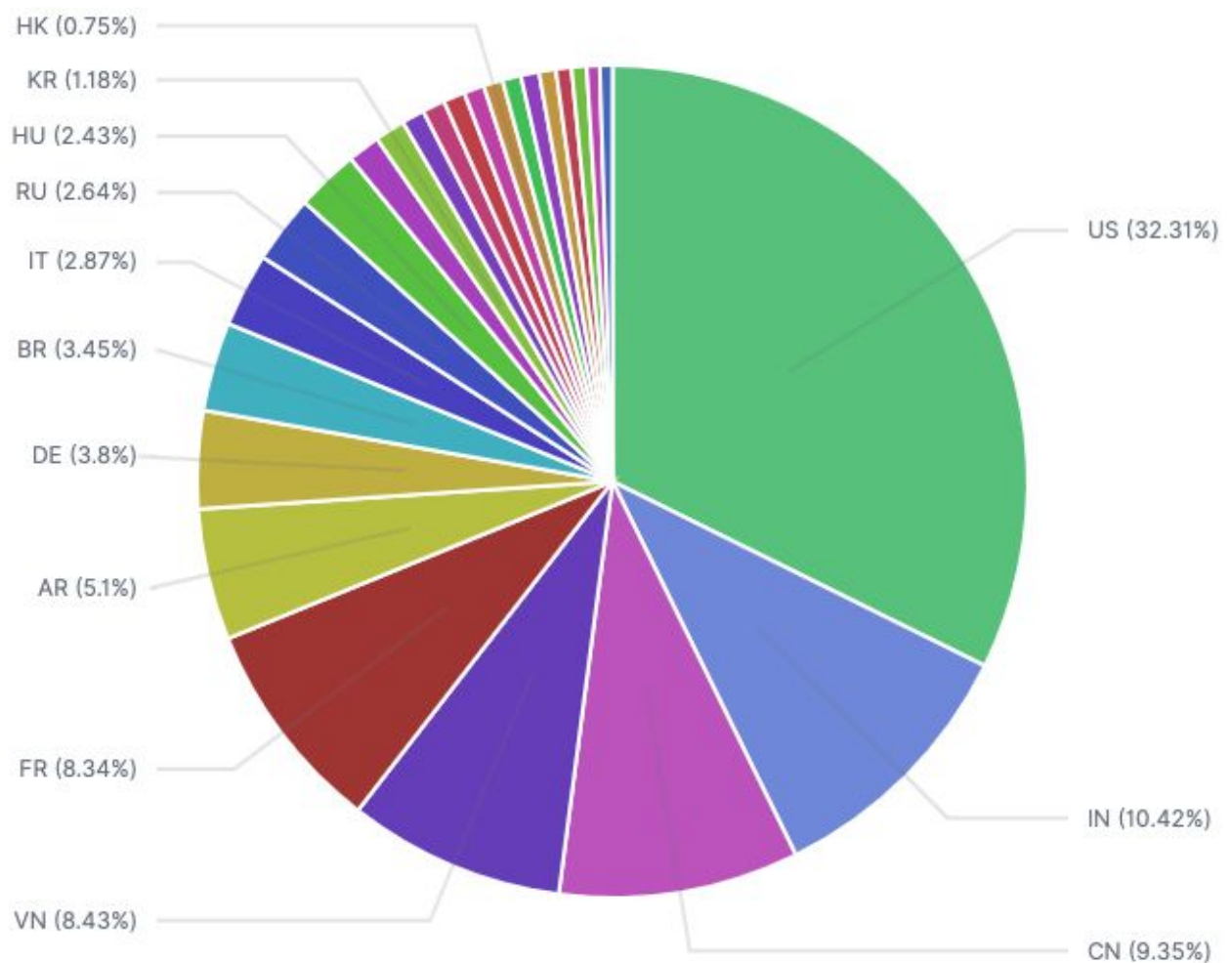

## COVID-19 Email Spam Statistics

RiskIQ analyzed its spam box feed for the time period of 04/07/2020-04/08/2020. During this period, RiskIQ analyzed 218,364 spam emails containing either “\*corona\*” or “\*covid\*” in the subject line. There were 20,469 unique subject lines observed during the reporting period. The spam emails originated from 9,095 unique sending email domains and 16,506 unique SMTP IP Addresses. Analysts identified 981 emails which sent an executable file for Windows machines.

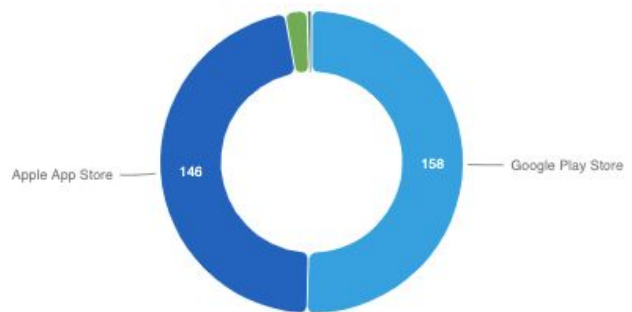

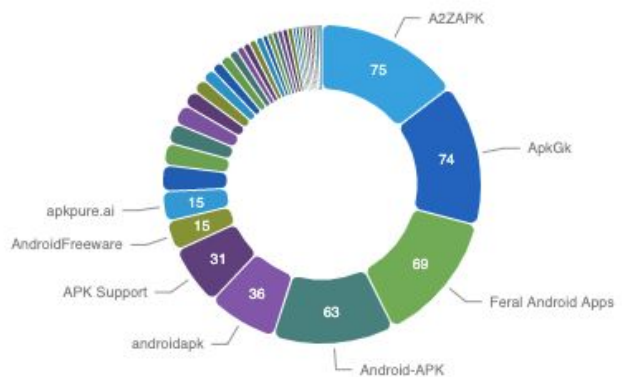

## Governmental Guidance

### State & Local Governments

#### California

As of 04/08/2020, California has 17,625 confirmed COVID-19 cases and 452 deaths. Governor Newsom [stated](#) yesterday that staying at home is making a difference for the state of California. COVID-19 hospitalizations rose by 4% Tuesday, as opposed to the double digit jumps California experienced last week. Newsom said the projected curve is starting to bend, but this is also pushing back the peak date until late May which could give the state more time to prepare for the medical needs of a peak. This projection differs from other projections which estimated the peak would come within the next couple weeks.

#### Illinois

As of 04/08/2020, Illinois has 13,553 confirmed cases of COVID-19 and 380 deaths. The daily [death toll](#) in Illinois hit a high yesterday with 73 deaths. On Tuesday, several [checkpoints](#) were set up by Chicago Police throughout the city in order to enforce the stay-at-home policy. The checkpoints will be held in each police district throughout 04/07/2020 - 04/09/2020 between 10:00 p.m. and 2:00 a.m.

#### Massachusetts

As of 04/08/2020, Massachusetts has confirmed 15,202 cases of COVID-19 and 356 deaths. Governor Baker [announced](#) Tuesday an \$800-million investment plan to aid local hospitals, nursing homes, and health care providers amid the COVID-19 pandemic.

#### New York

As of 04/08/2020, New York has confirmed 140,386 COVID-19 cases and 5,489 deaths. Mayor Bill de Blasio [announced](#) the importance of staying home and continuing social distancing as data displays the progress it has made thus far. COVID-19 hospitalizations have begun to stabilize and there is a reduced need for ventilators in New York City.

## Washington, DC

As of 04/08/2020, the Washington, DC region has a total of 10,634 confirmed COVID-19 cases with 3,659 in Virginia, 5,531 in Maryland, and 1,444 in the District. The District of Columbia has a total of 28 deaths, Virginia has 75, and Maryland has 124 deaths. The D.C. Council [passed](#) another emergency relief COVID-19 bill, which established a rent freeze throughout the district and mortgage payment deferrals, along with Mayor Bowser extending the emergency orders for 90 days.
