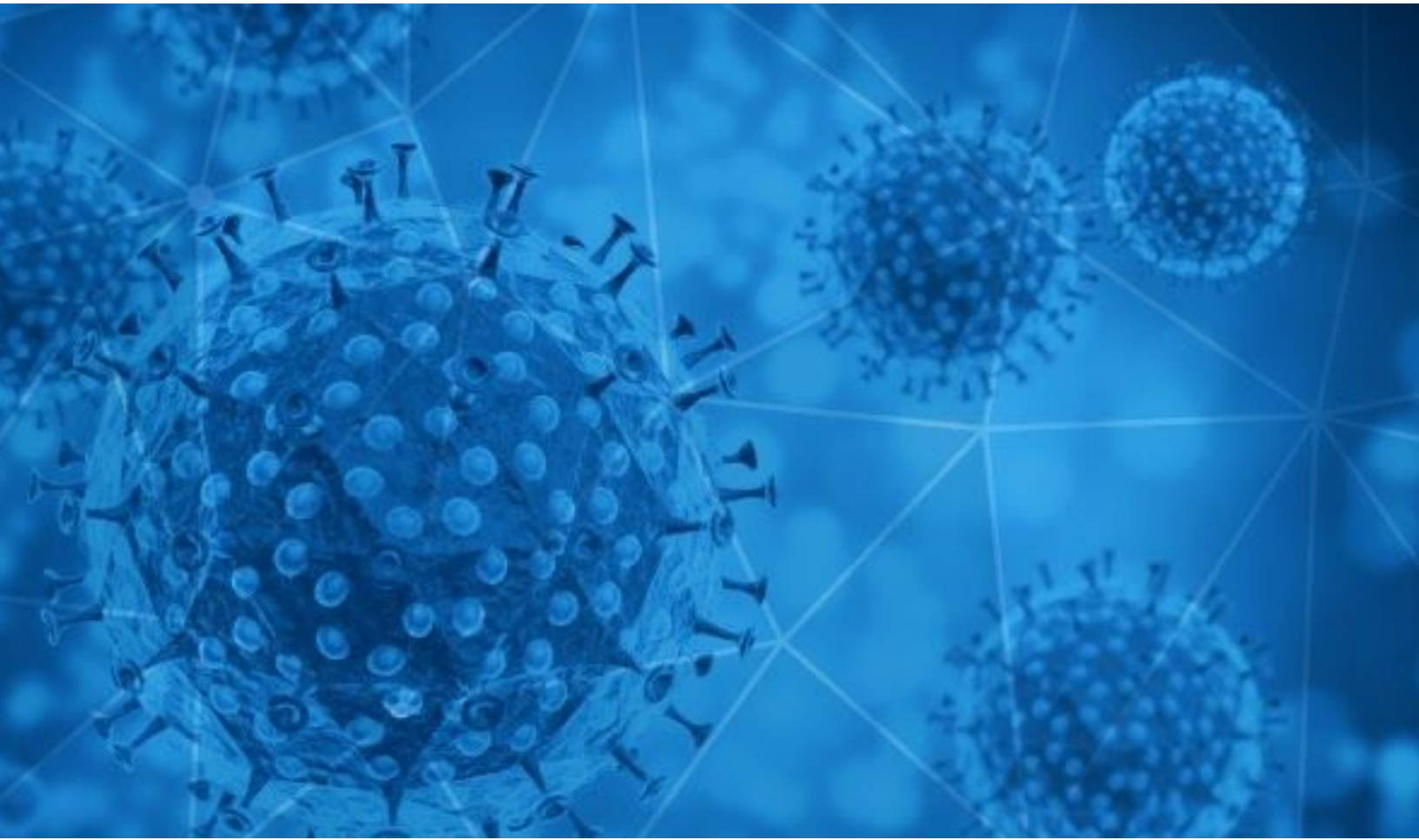

Notable Events: Previous 24 Hours

The U.S. surpassed [100,000 confirmed COVID-19 cases](#), with more than 1,600 fatalities. The number of cases grew by approximately 18,000 on Friday, 03/27/2020, marking the highest single day increase to date.

President Trump signed the [\\$2 trillion stimulus bill](#) into law on Friday, 03/27/2020, after the House passed the bill. Members of the House used a procedural maneuver to stop attempts by Representative Thomas Massie, R-KY, to require members to vote in person. Under the stimulus bill, individuals making \$75,000 or less will receive \$1,200 and married couples making \$150,000 or less will receive \$2,400, plus \$500 for each child.

President Trump on Friday, 03/27/2020, used the [Defense Production Act](#) for the first time to order General Motors (GM) to begin production on much-needed ventilators.

Digital Exploitation

The Ryuk Ransomware operators continue to [target hospitals](#), even as these organizations are overwhelmed during the coronavirus pandemic. (Please see RiskIQ's intelligence report entitled, "[Ransomware Attacks the Next Consequence of the Coronavirus Outbreak](#)," dated 03/03/2020, for additional information on the tools and techniques preferred by threat actors during times of regional or global crisis.)

A new COVID-19 [bitcoin scam](#) promises victims "millions" by working from home. According to a Malwarebytes blog posting, the dubious COVID-19 bitcoin missives are sent via phishing emails.

According to Naked Security reporting on 03/26/2020, researchers have seen evidence that hackers are targeting [home delivery](#) food apps. The hackers use the apps in an effort to scam customers out of their personal information, including their credit card numbers.

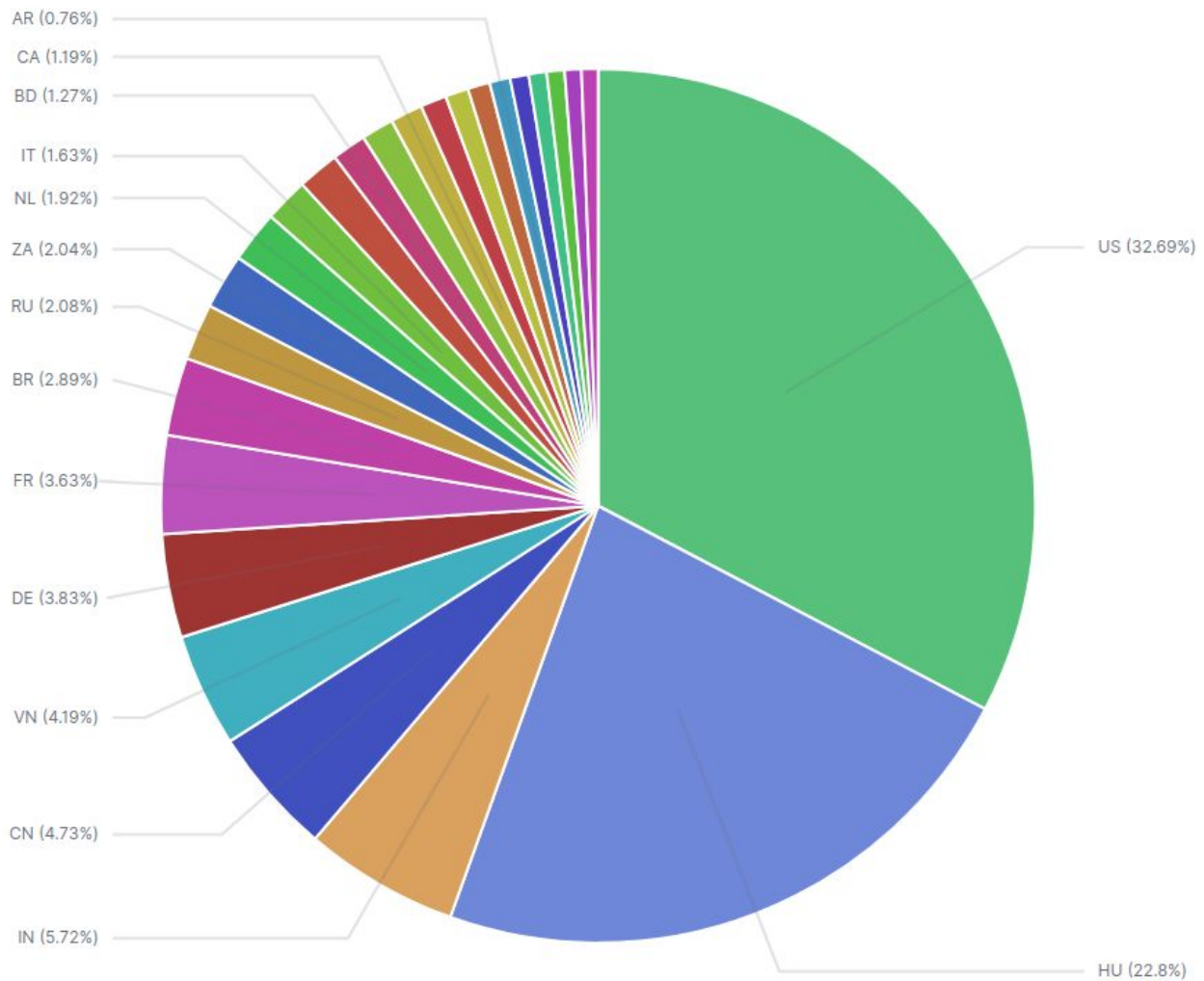

COVID-19 Email Spam Statistics

RiskIQ analyzed its spam box feed for the time period of 03/27/2020-03/28/2020. During this period, RiskIQ analyzed 81,823 spam emails containing either “*corona*” or “*covid*” in the subject line. There were 9,739 unique subject lines observed during the reporting period. The spam emails originated from 11,856 unique sending email domains and 12,296 unique SMTP IP Addresses. Analysts identified 1,026 emails which sent an executable file for Windows machines.

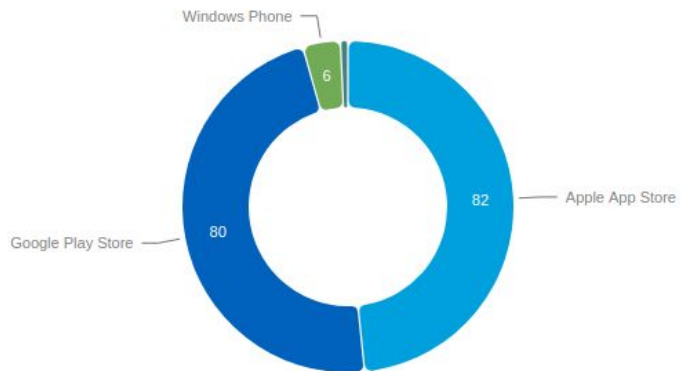

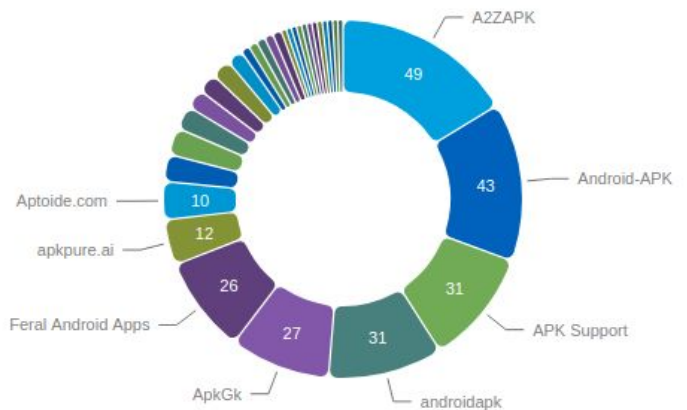

Governmental Guidance

State & Local Governments

California

As of 03/28/2020, California has 4,885 confirmed COVID-19 cases and 102 deaths. Los Angeles Mayor Eric Garcetti [said](#) the city is partnering with local clothing manufacturers with a goal of producing 5 million protective masks. The masks will be made to standards for people who deal with the public on a regular basis. They will not be made to the N-95 standards used by doctors and nurses. Illinois

As of 03/28/2020, Illinois has 3,029 confirmed cases of COVID-19 and 34 deaths. Chicago Mayor Lori Lightfoot [announced](#) a new COVID-19 Housing Assistance Program that will offer 2,000 grants of \$1,000 each. Chicago applicants have to provide documentation showing how they've been economically affected by the COVID-19 crisis, such as unemployment insurance claims, notices of employment status change and proof of household income at or below 60% of the area median income prior to job loss.

Massachusetts

As of 03/28/2020, Massachusetts has 3,240 confirmed cases of COVID-19 and 35 deaths. Boston Mayor Marty Walsh [announced](#) Friday that a dedicated coronavirus testing facility for Boston's first responders will open Saturday at Suffolk Downs in East Boston. The city is working with officials from Boston fire, police and other public safety agencies that are part of the city's coronavirus response to establish guidelines for how the new facility will operate.

New York

As of 03/28/2020, New York has 46,094 confirmed COVID-19 cases and 605 deaths. New York City makes up more than half of the statewide cases of COVID-19 with 26,697. New York Governor Andrew Cuomo [announced](#) Friday that New York public schools will remain closed until at least April 14 amid the COVID-19 pandemic. This is an extension of the original closures through April 1.

Washington, DC

As of 03/28/2020, the Washington, D.C.-region has a total of 1,689 confirmed COVID-19 cases with 606 in Virginia, 775 in Maryland, and 308 in the District. Hospital executives in Maryland [received a letter](#) from the state Health Department on Friday warning them to conserve masks, and to follow guidelines issued by the CDC on personal protective equipment. Under the CDC guidance and the state's conservation order, hospitals are to use masks beyond the manufacturer-designated shelf-life, re-use masks on a limited basis, and use them when there is contact with a patient.
