RiskIQ analyzed its spam box feed for the time period of 2020-11-04 to 2020-11-05. During this period, RiskIQ analyzed 43,906 spam emails containing either “*corona*” or “*COVID*” in the subject line. There were 3,119 unique subject lines observed during the reporting period. The spam emails originated from 2,153 unique sending email domains and 4,364 unique SMTP IP Addresses. Analysts identified 1 emails which sent an executable file for Windows machines.
